- Sanjayan Rajasingham is working to help students of FOCUS imaginatively engage the university with the gospel. Please pray for him as he seeks out the main apologetic concerns present in the university and helps Christian students to develop relevant evangelistic material. The NSE is also in the process of developing a discussion paper on the nature of the university to share with the student unions and administration. The Council of FOCUS hopes to produce a policy paper on Higher Education in the coming months which will be used as a basis for discussion with relevant authorities.
- Please pray for Menura Perera, who will rejoin the staff team in February after his exams. We continue to pray and search for permanent staff, especially female staff workers to serve on the staff team.


